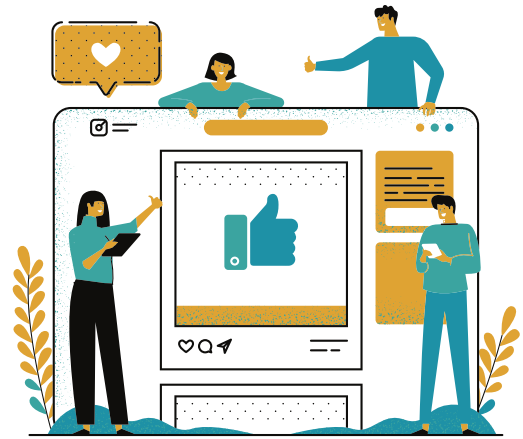


### What is DIGIDEM?
