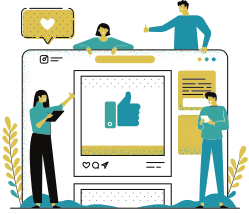

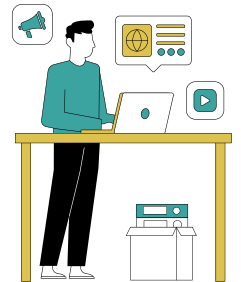

Erasmus+ project



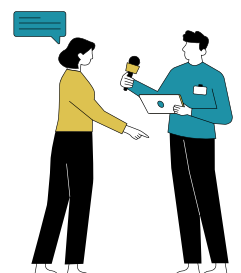
The **DIGIDEM** project aims to develop an innovative and comprehensive curriculum that **enhances digital skills and fosters civic engagement** in today's digital world. Made for **students, teachers, educators, administrators and associations**, **DIGIDEM** promotes a **more responsible, ethical and informed use** of digital spaces.

By fostering **critical thinking, media literacy and active digital citizenship**, **DIGIDEM** empowers participants to **navigate online spaces safely, fight against misinformation and engage effectively in the digital world**. It also includes **gamification** to make learning more engaging.



Managed by **Clermont Auvergne University**, **DIGIDEM** has been made possible thanks to partners from **six European countries**: France, Türkiye, Portugal, Malta, Italy and Luxembourg. **Interactive educational resources** will be **developed and tested** within partner institutions before being **disseminated on a European scale**.

With an overall duration of **36 months** (2024–2027) and supported by a **€400,000 budget**, the Erasmus+ **DIGIDEM** project aims to **integrate digital citizenship into university curricula** while **providing educators** with innovative **teaching tools** tailored to **today's digital challenges**.

The **DIGIDEM** project is structured around a series of **interconnected Work Packages (WPs)** designed to **ensure efficient management, innovative research and impactful educational outcomes**. Each WP plays a **crucial role** in shaping the success of the project by **integrating research-driven strategies, accessibility considerations and sustainability measures**.

At the **core** of the initiative is **NetizenSphere**, a **dynamic, interactive platform aimed at fostering digital citizenship education**. Through **cutting-edge research and stakeholder collaboration**, the project will establish a **curriculum** that not only **equips students with essential digital skills** but also **promotes critical thinking, ethical online behaviour and civic engagement**.

WORK PACKAGE #1

– Monitoring & Management –
Ensuring an effective execution, financial oversight and risk mitigation, prioritizing sustainability and inclusivity in digital education.

WORK PACKAGE #2

– Research & Platform Development –
Identifying the best practices in digital literacy and developing a platform with engaging, research-based adaptable content.

WORK PACKAGE #3

– Digital Citizenship Curriculum –
Integrating VR and AR to enhance learning about misinformation, online safety and ethical technology use.

WORK PACKAGE #4

– Implementation & Sustainability –
Focusing on training educators and establishing long-term strategies for curriculum integration.

– Advanced Digital Skills –
Providing workshops, industry collaboration and awareness campaigns to provide students with cybersecurity, media literacy and data privacy skills.
